PICK-UP-FROM-THE-PROPERTY SYSTEM:



RESIDUAL WASTE

- Rubbish, Vacuum cleaner bags
- Remnants , Leather and rubber waste
- Sanitary products (sanitary towels, tampons, panty liners)
- Nappies, wet wipes, Paper tissues
- Paper hand towels
- Ash from coal and coke
- Flat glass, drinking glasses
- Toothbrushes
- Cigarette butts
- X-ray images, photos, slides



WASTE PAPER

- Newspapers, Magazines
- Brochures, catalogues
- Glossy mags
- Books, notebooks
- Letters and envelopes
- Gift wrapping paper
- Wrapping paper
- Uncoated frozen food cartons
- Paper carrier bags
- Folded cardboard boxes
- Cardboard egg boxes



ORGANIC WASTE

- Fallen fruit, crop residues
- Banana peels and citrus fruit peels
- Meat and other food leftovers, Bones
- Eggshells
- Paper coffee filters, teabags
- Paper kitchen towels and paper serviettes
- Cut flowers, Houseplants
- Compostable cat litter
- Small-animal droppings
- Wood ash



YELLOW SACK/BIN

- Plastic packaging, e.g. shampoo bottles, washing detergent and cleaning product bottles, butter tubs, meat bowls, cooking-oil bottles, vinegar bottles, yoghurt pots, take-away cups, sausage and cheese packaging, plastic film, PET bottles**
- Packaging made of metal and aluminium, e.g.crown corks, screw caps, tubes, pet food tins, aluminium trays, beverage cans and tin cans**
- Packaging made of material composite, e.g. beverage cartons, blister packs, crisps packaging, coffee packaging, frozen food packaging, ready-to-serve soup bags, instant coffee jars
- Packaging made of polystyrene, e.g. polystyrene cups, polystyrene chips and polystyrene packaging, electrical appliances
- Packaging made of fabric, e.g. jute sacks, cotton sacks, fruit and vegetable nets
- Packaging made of wood, e.g. small fruit trays, cake boxes made of wood, etc.
- Packaging made of porcelain, ceramics, clay and earthenware, e.g. cosmetic jars, food vessels (fondues, pies, ...)
- Packaging made of biodegradable materials,
 e.g.film or trays made of cornflour,
 "bioplastic packaging"

**NOTE: Starting in 2025, there will be a deposit on beverage bottles and cans.

RECYCLING POINT SYSTEM:



WASTE GLASS

- All glass packaging segregated into white glass and coloured glass:
- Disposable bottles (beer, wine, juice bottles)
- Flacons, scent bottles
- Medicine bottles
- Disposable spice mills
- Glass closures (e.g. Vino-Lok)



OLD TEXTILES

Not possible at all collection points.

- Please only deposit clean,
- usable items of clothing, underwear,
- cloths, ties.
- hand towels, duvets, cushions.
- handbags, belts,
- shoes (only bundled in pairs)

RECYCLING CENTRE SYSTEM:



- ⊙ Treated, untreated or coated waste wood such
- ⊙ wooden windows without glass, wooden

- panels, wooden cladding.
- Exception: plastic-coated wood.

IMPORTANT: Railway sleepers, impregnated stakes and masts must be delivered to an authorised waste disposal company as hazardous waste.



- Corrugated cardboard and large uncoated packaging boxes such as sales packaging of electrical appliances or self-assembly furniture,
- cardboard trays for fruit and vegetables
- as well as shipping boxes.

Please flatten the cardboard boxes at home!



SCRAP IRON

- Metal scrap and small metal items such as
- bicycles, metal sheets, wheelbarrows,
- or roof gutters, pots and pans, cutlery and
- miscellaneous iron equipment.



BULKY WASTE

- All bulky objects that are too large for the residual waste bin and cannot be recycled.
 For example,
- \odot upholstered furniture, PVC pipes, skis,
- Heraklith boards, floor coverings, suitcases,



GREEN CUTTINGS

 Grass cuttings, leaves and hedge clippings – twigs up to a maximum diameter of 2 cm



Tree and shrub cuttings



HARD PLASTIC

- Objects made of hard plastics such as
- crates, buckets, garden furniture,
- watering cans, etc.



 These comprise all hazardous and toxic wastes, including vessels containing harmful residues, that normally occur in private households
 None will be accepted from industrial companies.



BUILDING -RUBBLE (recyclable)

CONSTRUCTION

O Plaster, mortar, rendering, fireclay, chimneys,

ceramics, broken glass, cement.

aerated concrete, porous concrete (Ytong), tiles,

- Bricks, masonry (not incl. mortar or plaster),
- roof tiles, shingles, concrete, asphalt,
- natural stone/sandstone, demolished screed,
- exposed aggregate concrete slabs,
- paving stones, clay materials, stones, etc.



- Small electrical appliances, large electrical app-
- ⊘ liances, monitors, refrigerators, energy-saving
- bulbs, rechargeable / non-rechargeable batteries.



ASBESTOS CEMENT

"Eternit" roof and façade panels, flower boxes
 and pipes made of asbestos cement. Only in small quantities from private households!
